The Little Angel and the Shepherd Children (Play)

Actors:

Joseph and Mary; 3 shepherds; 4 shepherd children: Bob and Timothy, Sue and Jessica; 4 animals: a squirrel, a hare, a fox and a wolf; 2 angels: the big angel Gabriel and the little angel Chris.

Introduction

Director (or prompter):

It was a wondrous night, when angels came to the earth, when animals started to speak and when even a little angel became disobedient, because he wanted to see a newborn child. This is the night our play tells about.

In the field

Shepherd 1: It's a very quiet night.
Shepherd 2: You're right. It *is* very quiet.
Shepherd 3: And the stars are twinkling more brightly than ever.
Shepherd 1: Yes, the stars are very bright tonight.
Shepherd 2: Look at that star over there.
Shepherd 3: It's getting brighter and brighter.
Shepherd 1: It's getting closer and closer.
Shepherd 2: Oh look! It isn't a star, it's an angel. A big angel.
Shepherd 3: And there's a small angel beside him.
Bob: What a wondrous night.
Angel Gabriel: Hello, good shepherds. My name is Gabriel. I'm the boss of all the angels. And this is one of my guardian angels.
Shepherd 1: Angel Gabriel and a guardian angel! Wow! Hello, angels!
Shepherd 2: And why have you come to us poor shepherds?
Angel Gabriel: I want to tell you some good news. Jesus Christ, the king of the world, was born tonight.
Shepherd 3: You mean, the Lord's son was born tonight?
Angel Gabriel: Yes, exactly.

Shepherds 1, 2, 3 and shepherd children (*talking excitedly at the same time*):
Where? Please, tell us where! Yes, tell us, where he was born. Where is he now?
